The Rocky Mountaineer train, designed especially with you in mind, travels through the day and stops for the night and ensuring you don't miss any of the phenomenal scenery and yet have a comfortable bed for the night.

This spectacular Rocky Mountaineer itinerary takes you through the Northern Rockies' extreme and diverse landscapes into pristine and rarely seen wilderness from Vancouver to Whistler and on to Jasper with overnight stops in Whistler and Quesnel. This runs in both directions every few days from mid May until mid September.

As an alternative you can choose Journey Through the Clouds which travels between Vancouver and Jasper, or the First Passage to the West which travels between Vancouver and Banff or Calgary.

There are a number of different itineraries with the Rocky Mountaineer and all can be added to a tailor-made holiday to suit you. Day 1-2



Vancouver

Fly from the UK and arrive in Vancouver and spend time exploring this scenic city on your own. Visit Gastown, take a small ferry to Granville Island, explore Stanley Park or do some shopping on Robson Street.

2 nights in Vancouver.

Day 3



Vancouver to Whistler

Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from North Vancouver to the mountain resort Whistler, renowned for outstanding skiing and year-round outdoor activities, its an amazing hub in the summer too. You will be transferred from downtown Vancouver and then the Rocky Mountaineer will take you on a breathtaking rail journey through the stunning scenery of the Sea to Sky Corridor. Highlights of the trip include spectacular views of Howe Sound and the Coast Mountains, Brandywine Falls, Mount Garibaldi and the impressive Cheakamus Canyon. On arrival at the Whistler train station, you will be transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. Breakfast will be included on the train.

1 night in Whistler.

Day 4



Whistler to Quesnel

Continue onboard the Rocky Mountaineer to the charming rural town of Quesnel, gateway to the North Cariboo. Enjoy breathtaking and varied scenery, from the river canyons and lush farmland of the Pemberton Valley to the desert-like conditions of the Fraser Canyon to rolling hills and vast ranchlands of the Cariboo Plateau. Highlights include the shorelines of Anderson Lake and glacial-fed Seton Lake, sweeping views of the Fraser Canyon and the crossing of Deep Creek Bridge, one of the highest railway bridges in the world. The Rocky Mountaineer follows the banks of the Fraser River into Quesnel.

1 night in Quesnel.

Day 5



Quesnel to Jasper

Your journey continues eastwards today to the beautiful Canadian Rockies and Jasper National Park. Follow the Fraser River north to the town of Prince George, then travel east through the forests of northern British Columbia, home to plentiful wildlife, including a large population of moose. View the steeply rising Rocky Mountains and to the south the Cariboo Mountains. Continue climbing past Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, and through the Yellowhead Pass into Alberta. You will continue on for an evening arrival into Jasper.

2 nights in Jasper.

Day 6



Jasper

Today is free to explore. We could book you on a scenic half-day tour of some of the park's natural attractions and rugged peaks. Maybe you will see a glimpse of the wildlife that calls this region home. Maybe take a tour to Maligne Lake and take a small cruise, or head up Whistler Mountain for the amazing views. Ask us for other tours.

Day 7



Jasper to Banff

Travel to Banff via the beautiful and scenic highway, the Icefields Parkway. A stop will be made at Athabasca Falls before arriving at the Columbia Icefield. Here you will ride on an Ice Explorer to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier. Your driver/guide will explain how glaciers are formed and point out some interesting geological features. Time will be

available for lunch included at the Glacier Discovery Centre. Afterwards, a brief stop will be made at Bow Lake before arriving in Banff this afternoon.

Day 8



Banff

Today you will have an entire day to spend exploring Banff National Park on your own. Optional activities include soaking in the mineral pools at Upper Hot Springs, enjoying a nature walk on nearby mountain trails, visiting Banff's historic museums, cruising on Lake Minnewanka or playing a round of golf at The Fairmont Banff Springs. Day 9



Banff to Lake Louise

A morning half-day transfer takes you into Yoho National Park to view some of its natural wonders. Among the attractions are the Spiral Tunnels, Emerald Lake and a natural rock bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. The transfer ends in Lake Louise, where the remainder of the afternoon is at your leisure to enjoy this awe-inspiring location.

2 nights in Lake Louise.

Day 10

Enjoy a free day in Lake Louise. Local activities include canoeing, hiking in the mountains or simply relaxing and taking in the magnificent views. Ask us for day tours.

Day 11



Lake Louise to Calgary

Today you will have a sightseeing tour of Banff National Park. Among the points of interest are Bow Falls, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner, and the Hoodoos. A trip on the Banff Gondola is included before heading to Calgary.
