The Hotel de Glace is just 30 minutes from Quebec City and is open from early January to the end of March. This amazing structure, built every year, offers you all the comfort you could possibly imagine in a magnificent building of ice and snow. The ceilings are up to 18 feet high, the walls are covered with artwork and the furniture is made out of blocks of ice. The Hotel de Glace has 30 rooms which vary from simple bedrooms to more exotic rooms with fire places and one that even has a hot tub! There is a chapel, a huge reception room with a functional fire place, and the Ice Bar. ## **Quebec City to Hotel de Glace**

Transfer to the Hotel de Glace for your overnight stay.

Before spending a night at the Hotel de Glace, you will be invited to attend a briefing by the guides. They will be happy to walk you through the unique experience of sleeping in an ice hotel and will tell you everything you need to know about the equipment available. All the beds have a solid ice base, with a wooden bedspring and mattress on top. When evening comes, a cozy arctic sleeping bag will be delivered to your room. The ambient bedroom temperature will remain between -3°C and -5°C, no matter the outside temperature. You will have time to enjoy the relaxation area with its outdoor spas and saunas, nearby you can go dogsledding, or don a pair of snow shoes to explore your surroundings. You will also have a room in the nearby Hotel Valcartier for the night to store luggage, shower or even sleep if preferred.
